

## ZTECHNIK VSTREAM POLYCARBONATE WINDSCREEN

National Cycle developed an incredible polycarbonate windscreen for the BMW 1200 GS Adventure. The screen is made of FMRcoated polycarbonate, which is 3x more scratch resistant and 10x stronger than the original screen. At 23" in height, it certainly will protect the rider from all the unwanted elements.

The aftermarket part is slightly higher than the manufacturer's OEM, which certainly works in your favor. The advanced "V" shaped contour

directs the wind further away from the front of the bike and around the rider, creating a quiet cocoon behind the screen.

My test consisted of various roads, highways, curving back roads, and the city. Throughout the test, it remained quiet, and the ride wasn't too choppy at high speeds.

At \$269.95 for the screen and \$79.95 for the headlight cover they are well worth the expense for the extra protection.
